



Door To Door Waste Collection and Segregation Programmes:

The project team on daily basis undertakes door-to-door waste collection and source segregation. The street cleaning is also a part of the daily activities which has been implemented uninterruptedly during the month of Sep 2024 in the project location.



Demonstration of Source Segregation Programmes:

Around 15 'Source Segregation Demonstration' programmes have been organized during the month of September 2024, on 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 8th, 10th, 12th, 15th, 16th, 18th, 20th, 21th in Ward 01 - Ondiveeran Nagar, Ward 04 - Olakuda, Ward 07 - Maravar street, Ward 10 - MK Nagar, Ward 12 - Periyapalli Vasal, Ward 16 - Attamal Street and Ward 21 – Kariyur locations have been covered through the awareness activity.

Our project team and green friends have given awareness to the households in the respective wards about the types of waste, segregation of waste and the importance and benefits of recycling. A live demonstration on Source Segregation was also organized for the public in which the importance and the need for source segregation were insisted. People were also explained about the process of global warming and land pollution which is caused due to non-segregating waste in the source area itself. Due to this the mixed waste is dumped in the dumping yard.



Swachhata Hi Seva Mass Cleaning Program:

On 21st September the Rameswaram project team organised a mass cleaning program which was conducted at the Agni Teertha Karai as part of the Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign. During this program Chairman, Commissioner, Sanitary Officer and Green Rameswaram project team implemented the activity.







Swachhata Hi Seva Medical Camp Program:

Rameswaram SWM project conducted а medical camp for the Green Friends as part of the Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign 2024 held on 25^{th} September. The camp was witnessed by the Commissioner. Chairman of Rames-Municipality. waram Around 100 Green Friends and the general



public were medical tested through this opportunity and were provided with basic medicines. In case of chronic or major illnesses, they were asked to visit the Government Hospital for further treatment.

Swachhata Hi Seva Awareness Programme:

on 26th September Swachhata Hi Campaign awareness Seva programme was conducted for the Government Primary school students in Rameswaram. The students were sensitized on the dangers of single-use plastics and how to properly segregate the waste. They were explained that in each class room waste can be segregated and thereby recycle the materials available with them. They were motivated and given the challenge to convert their school into a zero waste campus.
