Source Segregation Demonstration Programmes

Source Segregation Demonstration programmes are regularly done at the target community in order to raise awareness about Source Segregation at the houses and reduce the accumulation of waste converting into inert waste. In cognizance to this 17 Source Segregation Awareness / Demonstration programmes have been organized during the month of August 2024 on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 14th, 13th, 16th, 19th, 20th, 2st in Ward No.01- Sathya Nagar, Ward No.2 - Kattupillaiyar Street, Ward No.04 - Olakuda, Ward No.07 - Maravar Street, Ward No.11 - Pon Nagar, Ward No.14 -Thittakudi Street, Ward No.19 – Nararajapuram, Ward No.21- Kariyur localities.



Live demonstration on Source Segregation was also organized for the public in which the importance and the need for source segregation was explained in detail. People were explained about the processes of global warming and land pollution which are caused by mixing waste and throwing it into the waste bins which is dumped in the dumping yard.

Door to Door Awareness Programme

Forty, Door-to-Door Awareness programmes has been conducted in the Municipality on 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 13th, 14th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 20th, of September in Ward No.1 – Sathaya Nagar, Ward No.02- Kattu Pillaiyar Kovil Street, Ward No 03 - Paruvatham Road No.9 - Ramarpatham Street, Ward No.10 - Anna Nagar, Ward No.11 - MGS Nagar, Ward No.14 - Thittakudi Street, Ward No.17 - Verkodu, Ward No.20 – Ramakrishna Puram, Ward No.20 - Rameswaram Road, respectively. 1640 households have been sensitized on the issues of waste management in Rameswaram and about the importance of Municipal Solid Waste Management and segregation of waste at source in the households itself. They were also explained that this was the only solution for keeping the environment clean for a better future of the children.



Agni Theethakkarai Cleaning Work

On the occasion of Aadi Amavasai which fell on 4th August 2024, lakhs of devotees visited Rameswaram for bathing or having a holy dip in the Agni Theerthakkarai (Holy Water Body). In this scenario around 30 tonnes of garbage was generated, which was cleaned by the Green Rameswaram Project team and was disposed.
