Nandavanam of Temples

Nandavanam of each temple is famous for its usefulness in supplying flowers for the poojas and rituals. It also relates with the belief that maintenance of nature is the basic duty of all human being. Sthala Vruksham concept further endorses this school of thought. Nandavanam of Sri Ramanathasamy Temple is huge with more than 10000 square feet in its area.

Present status of the Nandavanam in Sri Ramanathasamy Temple

Currently there is absolutely no maintenance for Nandavanam. Thorny bushes and fallen trees and snakes welcomes you if you visit Nandavanam of Sri Ramanathasamy Temple. There are 6 Teertham wells also found inside Nandavanam of Sri Ramanathasamy Temple. Puranic reference to these Teerthams are unknown.

Efforts taken to Restore Nandavanam

With the advent of Green Rameswaram, efforts were taken to restore Nandavanam by occasionally cleaning the Nandavanams with volunteers (mostly students and seva sanghs) at least monthly once this happens. However, this is not enough considering the hugeness of the Nandavanam. Practically we require a dedicated person for maintaining the Nandavanam.

Through Green Pilgrimage Network support we tried to get project for reincarnation of the Nandavanam. However, after several rounds of discussion the authorities gave permission to do the work in the outskirts of North Tower. With much discussion we have tied up with Jeyam Nursery of Thangatchimadam for planting the trees.

There was huge debris, thorny bushes across the north tower outskirts. With the support of Hand in Hand team (Partner of Green Rameswaram) and local volunteers, we could clear the debris and thorny bushes.

Planting and Watering

After establishing the proper piping and water facility, following flower plants saplings (850) were planted
